She was a small woman but she was larger than life, to the extent that no one person could fill her shoes. We miss her here in the physical even as we are grateful that she guides us from the Court of the Ancestors."

Greetings all,

It is a great pleasure to address you in this new issue of the Correllian Times. The original Correllian Times was a work of love undertaken by our former First Elder the Beloved Windy Lajoie. It is a joy to see it reborn and I hope to see this iteration of the Correllian Times continue for many years.

It is especially appropriate to see the magazine revived as Samhaintide comes upon us in the remarkable year. For most of us this has been a difficult and trying year. Between the pandemic and the great social unrest that has swept the world, there has been a great deal of tension and anxiety even for people not directly touched by tragedy.

But this year has also brought blessings. Year 20 Aquarius has seen a huge shift in how much we use technology, as we have adapted to issues of shut-down and social distancing. This is most obvious in how much we are using online venues for events that would normally have been held in person. In our Correllian community this has included rituals and festivals which would otherwise have had to be cancelled and foregone, but in the wider world it extends to many people's work and schooling as well. Society was headed in this direction already of course, but Year 20 has forced society's hand and made what would have come in the future an immediate need and hence an immediate reality.

This does not mean of course that in-person gatherings are a thing of the past - far from it. No doubt we will return to in-person gatherings as soon as it is safe in our areas. But it also does not mean that as we return to in-person gatherings that we will cease to use the online venues that have been our salvation during this time. Instead, we will return to in-person gatherings but we still use our online venues as well. Indeed, I am sure that we will see many events that will be a combination of in-person gathering and online attendance, that will probably become the rule rather than the exception.



We in the Correllian Tradition were uniquely prepared to make this technological jump forward because we were already working on these ideas. Through the dedication and hard work of retiring First Elder and Paladin General Ser Ed Hubbard, we had already learned about these new technologies and were preparing to integrate them before the pandemic hit. We had expected to be using them in Year 21, but were able to speed up our use of them because much of the groundwork had already been laid.

This should be no surprise because the Correllian Tradition has always been at the forefront when it comes to adapting new technologies. Whether magazines like Wheel of Hekate (1986) or The Round Table (1994), radio shows like Psychic Chicago (1991) or Telepathic Radio (1999), internet learning systems like Witch School (2001), video like Magick TV (2005), podcasting like Pagans Tonight (2009), or now livecasting we have always strived to stay at the cutting edge. As Ser Ed likes to say “Love your message, not your platform” and we have and will continue to use every platform available to better reach and serve you, our community.

Ser Ed has always kept a keen eye on the newest technological developments, and because of this we have always been among the first to adapt new technologies -as we have again done this year.

Our first attempts at livecasting were at the Salem Witches’ Ball of 2010. At the time livecasting was expensive, balky, and required large pieces of equipment arrayed on something resembling a large tea cart, taken along to the site and accompanying our livecasters. Today, it is as simple as opening a program on your computer. How far we have come and how quickly! Imagine what we may be doing ten years from now. Virtual reality livecasting?



When I was young, we saw these things coming but most of us expected that they would be generations in the future, not things that we ourselves would live to see. Having seen so much now, I can barely imagine what we may be doing generations in the future! But whatever it is, you can be sure that we Correllians will be using it.

Our dedication is to serve Deity and to more fully embody the powers of the Soul in the physical, to teach and expand the Psychic Arts, and to spread knowledge and practice of Conscious Incarnation, so that you can make the fullest use of this and every incarnation! We will use every tool that presents itself to accomplish these goals. And I must say that it has been amazing watching new technological tools develop and learning how to adapt them to serve the metaphysical community.

This October we are doing the Halloween Psychic Fair throughout the entire month. As part of this we are offering a wide range of reading from psychics with many different skills, as well as things like séances. The other night I did a séance that included people here in Florida, but also in other states and as far away as Scotland. Having learned these skills in the '70s, I must tell you that I would never then have imagined being able to do such a thing! I have known people over the years who saw magic and technology as being somehow at odds, but as a Correllian I consider them two hands doing the same work -advancing us as a people to, again, more fully, more consciously embody Spirit in the physical world.

Magazines like the Correllian Times are definitely part of that work. They bring us together so that we can more fully share the journey into the future, share our experiences, and above all share new ideas and techniques. It will be a wonderful journey -I am sure that we will enjoy it!




This month I would like to talk about Divination and shadow work.

First let's describe what we mean by shadow self. Carl Jung defines the shadow self as basically anything hidden from the conscious mind, good or bad. As Correllians, we also believe in karmic entanglements that we have brought forth from previous lives.

So, not only will we be dealing with issues in our current life, but also issues from past lives. Facing your shadow self should not be this big, scary thing, but it might cause you to face trauma that you have suppressed. The trauma will need to be worked through safely, in order to let it go, so you can move forward. Because of this it is always advisable to tell your mentor or person you trust that you are going to do this.

Let's get started. For this example, I am going to be using Tarot as the form of divination, but you can use Runes or any other form of divination that works for you. When doing this, I personally either do a one card draw, or a three-card spread; but do what feels right for you.

November's Temple Highlight is **Four Pillars-Proto Temple**

Four Pillars was founded by Rev. Kyle Metzger HP in 2014 as a Personal Shrine. This was a largely personal worship center with very little involvement with the community. Rev. Kyle spent much of his time building the foundation and structure of the Shrine by creating the Constitution, building a webpage and eventually a youtube channel. Shortly thereafter, members began to join and the temple now hosts a modest group of members who meet often for rituals and Sabbats. In 2015 the Shrine was recognized as a Witan Shrine and then finally in 2018 elevated again to the status of Proto-Temple and have aspirations to attain full Temple status soon. This proto-Temple

is proud to have their own Crystal Web access point that is open to all members of the Temple and anyone who may be passing through is welcome to add their energies or use the crystal access point. The organization has two Inner Court members and a third studying for Inner Court status. Most of the members are members of the Correllian Tradition. The temple was founded on the mission of providing services to the community through worship and devotion as well teaching. The Four Principles are the Building blocks of this Temple: Study, Worship/Devotion, Service and Sustainable Living. The Four Pillars Proto-Temple hosts a monthly devotion and blessing ritual which occurs on the 1st of Each month as well as Live rituals for interested persons through various Social Media platforms. Sabbat rituals are regularly performed but not always broadcasted live. The organization has no Patron however the official Patroness is Gaia. The Four Pillars Proto-Temple is located near Youngstown, Ohio.

According to the Merriam-Webster Dictionary, the word “Holiday” comes from the Old English word *hāligdæg* meaning “holy-day”. This is defined as a day in which no work or school is done and it becomes a day in commemoration of a specific event. As the Wheel begins to turn toward the colder Months here in the Northern Hemisphere, we find many holidays which begin to change their focus from outward to inward. We see the shift from social or societal holidays to familial holidays and the importance is becoming more family centered.

November 11th- Lunantshees

There are many great holidays to discuss in the month of November but since I could only choose one, I decided on this one! This holiday is a lesser known Irish holiday that may still be practiced in some locations today. Little information has been known about this particular holiday as it is a largely folk observance with little written about it. Most sources come from journals and local accounts. In references to this holiday, there are references to a shift in the Irish Calendar which held this day on November 1st however due to that shift, the calendar was translated eleven days making the new day of observing Lunantshees on the 11th instead. Due to the association with the 1st, many elements of the holiday seem to be related to what many Wiccans and Pagans understand as Samhain and there are even references to the Wild Hunt in association with the day. November 11th was believed to be the day when the “bad” Sidhe (Faeries) would become more active and ride across the land causing mischief and misfortune. There are particular references to a figure named Nicnevin who has been referenced as either an ancient Irish Goddess or maybe even a Faerie Queen who was a fearsome, and ruthless woman. She is depicted sometimes as even being the leader of the Wild Hunt, although we know of many deities which have been cast in that same light including Odin himself. It was believed that between October 31st and November 11th that the frightful Nicnevin would ride out to steal the evil souls of humankind.

There are many references to Sidhe being evil beings. My personal opinion is that although there may be some tribes of Sidhe which are largely aggressive toward humans, I believe that there are others which are also benevolent. If you choose to honor this holiday and pay respect to the evil Sidhe to divert disaster then it is recommended that you leave a traditional offering of bread with honey on it and either a glass of milk or milk mixed honey poured upon the bread.
