This particular charge was created by the order members by sitting together in prayer and channeling direct spirit messages that were named in the charge. Those messages were then assembled into the charges presented here. In some cases inspiration was drawn by the most familiar charge given to us by Lady Doreen Valiente. The Ebony Knights sat for this project because we feel it is important for Black people to have a theological document from a polytheistic perspective that reflected participation with ethnically Black Deities. We also felt it important to participate in a process for attaining this piece of liturgy. Embodying the energy of these spirits and learning of their histories was empowering and unifying for us all and it was a great act of communal Correllian faith. We hope that other Black Clergy that celebrate polytheistic faith, as well as non-clergy spirit workers will consider channeling a charge for their own lives. Please, reflect with us on the Charge of the Black Goddess and Black God.

The Charge of The Black Goddess

Inspired by Doreen Valiente's "The Charge of The Goddess"

Be still my dear ones and listen. Listen to the words of Alkebulan's Primordial Mother, also known as the Black Goddess. Her name is whispered in the winds throughout the African plains, lush lands, the Pyramids of Giza and throughout the Ancestral homelands, and within the diaspora of Her children. Listen as the low whispers of our Ancestors invoke Her many names such as Nana Buluku (Dahomey); Yemeya (Yoruba); Mawu Lisa (Dahomey); Oya (Yoruba); Auset (Kemet); Mbaba Mwana Waresa (Zulu); Ma'at (Kemet); Atete (Ethiopia); Kianda (Angola); Gang Gang Sara (Tobago); Mami Wata (Bein); Unkulunkulu (Zulu); and Oshun (Yoruba).

Throughout the countless millennia of time, the Black Goddess sends Her message to those who know of Her, commune with Her and seek Her power from within. Her essence embraces those who seek Her spirit, Her magic and Her esoteric knowledge. That message is then reverberated through time and space with the mystical drums, sacred rituals, sacred ceremonies, magical Griots, Shamans and adept Healers.

If one has need to draw upon the powers of the Black Goddess, look to Her in Her Moon trinity and call upon the Ancestors to assist. For it is stated in Her whispers that She awaits those who invoke Her and Her powers. Call upon Her on the Full Moon when Her full energy is needed. Call upon Her on the New Moon when power is needed for building. Call upon Her on a Darkening Moon when there is need for full elimination. For She is Iyalawo, Iyanifa or the Grand Mother High Priestess, and Her energy is infinite. She is All knowing. For it is told in Her whispers:

“When any of my children is in need, come and gather under the Moon in an esoteric place and draw upon my spirit in adulation. Gather to know and learn from Me for I am the Queen of Witches, the first Sorceress, the teacher of the ancients and the adept. Know that I have always been with you and will forever be. And you shall be free to dance to my rhythms as with your Ancestors, and to be who you were born to be. For I have blessed you with the gift and the beauty of melanin so that you are children of the Sun, and so that your movements are to be concealed under the Moon. Feel your natural energy, ecstasy of spirit and enjoy music and love. Rejoice in all in praise of Me. Intoxicate yourself with the love of my holy spirit. For I am the Mother of all Creation and all Creation is my children. I am the Mother who gave birth to the whole of the Universe, and I have blessed my children with the bounty upon this Earth. The only sacrifice I require is that from the heart, and to have compassion for others.

Know that you are the embodiment of Me through the magic of my stardust and my frequency. You are immortal. Therefore, strive to be all that you are meant to be with the highest of ideals. Drink from my vessel the wine of ecstasy and the loving sweetness of my waters. Stay

connected to your heart, for your heart is connected to Me, and you will always be blessed with the knowing, reverence and righteousness. Let no others deter you from that path.

Know that All things have originated from Me, and that someday All will return to Me. For I am the Alpha and the Omega. I am the beginning and the end. From Me came goddesses and gods. Worship Me and you worship the self. Love yourself as you love Me. Listen and hear upon my whispers. ### *MOTHER'S CORNER - Imbolc*

It is the time of fire and light here in the northern hemisphere. Winter is starting to wind down and we are counting the days until spring. This is the time to honor Brighid, the goddess of hearth fires, spring, renewal, fertility, poetry, battle, crafts and domestic life. But how do we teach children about this wonderful season while being stuck indoors due to the cold and snow. We spend a day celebrating domestic life. Grab the littles and cook a comfort food meal together and enjoy it under a pile of blankets or a blanket fort. Call it your hibernating tent and talk about the animals currently hibernating that are about to wake up with the coming warm weather. Also, the kitchen is our center of ritual activity and the hearth goddess works wonderfully with this. We also add a statue of Brighid on the counter near the stove as we do not have a fireplace. The children love to see her when they come home from school and thank her as they grab snacks from the fridge all month long.

Another fun project we do on Imbolc is make a Brigid's cross to hang on their bedroom doors. The cross is a symbol of the goddess and is traditionally made with wheat stalks to represent her hair. We also made a small Brigid's crown to put atop our statue. When the kids were little, we simply used colorful pipe cleaners as they were easier for the littles to bend into shape. Then we make our own candles to decorate the altar and symbolize the fire aspect of the season. White to symbolize the snow, red for the sun and green for the goddess. This is also a time to add a few seeds into an indoor pot and the kids love to place little plastic animals to represent the coming births. Altar offerings are generally eggs, milk or other dairy items left daily and given to the earth in the evening. With the price of eggs lately, plastic ones work well unless you are able to provide real ones.



On Imbolc we also do a thorough sweep of the home and renew the blessing on the house. If it happens to be warm enough we go outside for a nature walk and see if there are any signs of spring and talk about the rebirth of the home being just as important as the rebirth of nature. The kids also love to decorate with anything they find on the nature walk as it brings it indoors to remind us that soon the earth will awaken from under its snow blanket and nature will soon be in full bloom.

### *THE QUIET CORNER - Snow Moon Letting Go*



The Naudowessie band of the Dakota tribe named the moon in February the Snow Moon as it is generally the snowiest month of the year. We celebrate the midpoint between the winter solstice and the spring equinox this month as the light grows and signs of spring can be found, unless there's a heavy blanket of snow of course. But we feel the changes are coming and dream about the warmer months as they approach. We begin to think about the things in our lives that we are holding onto and allow the snow to blanket us, comfort us. But this is a perfect time to release those things that are holding us back. Grab a blanket, a candle, a journal and a cup of snow or ice water. Wrap the blanket around you, light the candle and find a comfortable spot to sit. Close your eyes and imagine a circle of protection springing up around you. Call on your spirit guides, ancestors and the elements to join you in your circle. Ask them to assist you in letting go of the things that are no longer safe for you in life. Ask them for protection and write down anything that they provide you such as words of comfort or pictures. Realize that snow is a blanket, a protection but it also keeps us frozen in time. Picture it melting and quenching the thirst of the new plants that are still under the ground. It provides life to these plants as they move upward into the sun. Now see the things holding you back moving from inside of your body to the



outside, just as the new plants shed the safety of their seed pods, you push your old pod off and begin a new start. Allow the old habits to melt with the rest of the snow around you and nourish you as you begin a new positive life. Pick up the cup of snow and speak the habits you are letting go of into it. Thank them for serving you until now and allow them to settle in the snow. Blow out the candle, thank the spirits that have joined you and take the cup of snow outside. Pour it onto the ground and offer it to the earth.

## *RAINBOW TENT FOR THE LGBTQ+ COMMUNITY - Orientation*

Hello Rainbow Tent Family and Allies,

Each month the article for the Order of The Rainbow Tent will be about those holidays and moments of commemoration across the LGBTQ+ community. February people think about Valentine's Day or Lupercalia

For some members of the community, this could be hard especially if you identify as asexual or aromantic.

### WHAT DO ASEXUAL & AROMANTIC MEAN?

What is asexuality?

Asexuality is an orientation defined by a lack of sexual attraction. This means that an asexual (or 'ace') person experiences little or no sexual draw towards others, and has little or no desire to have sexual relationships with other people. However, the asexual spectrum has many nuanced identities that fall under the umbrella term 'asexual'. Some of the more common ones are gray sexuality or gray-asexuality, where someone experiences sexual attraction rarely or infrequently. Another common identity is demisexuality or demi-asexuality, where someone only experiences sexual attraction after forming a close emotional or romantic bond with another person. There are many other identities on the ace spectrum (check out our Glossary to

find out about them!), but what they all have in common is the lack, to varying extents, of sexual attraction.

What is aromanticism?

Aromanticism is an orientation characterized by a lack of romantic attraction. While asexuality is a sexual orientation, aromanticism is a romantic orientation, and the two don't necessarily correlate. Someone may be asexual but not aromantic, or vice versa or they may be on both spectrums. An aromantic (or 'aro') person experiences little to no romantic attraction toward other people, and has little or no desire to form a romantic relationship with anyone. Like asexuality, aromanticism is a spectrum, which includes gray-romanticism or gray-aromanticism, where someone occasionally or rarely experiences romantic attraction, and demi-romanticism or demi-aromanticism, where someone only experiences romantic attraction after forming a strong emotional bond with another person. 'Aromanticism' is considered an umbrella term that encompasses all the identities that fall on the aromantic spectrum.

What's the difference between sexual and romantic orientation?

Asexuality and aromanticism are both orientations characterized by a lack of attraction, but they fall on different spectrums of attraction. What is considered sexual attraction and what is considered romantic attraction is quite subjective and complicated, but broadly, sexual attraction can be considered a physical desire for partnered sexual activity, while romantic attraction can be thought of as more emotion-based, although demonstrations of romantic affection might include physical gestures such as holding hands, cuddling, or kissing — it varies from person to person. It's not uncommon for people's sexual orientation and romantic orientation to be different, especially within the ace/aro community, where someone might be asexual but not aromantic, or vice versa, but many people whose orientations align may never have thought to separate the two (and that's OK too!).

Sexual orientation vs. sex drive

Here's a catch: what's not a sign of your (a)sexuality is your sex drive or 'libido'. Your libido is different from your sexual orientation: sexual attraction is directed at other people, while your libido is undirected; it's your desire or impulse to experience sexual satisfaction. If you have a high libido, you will experience sexual urges or desires, which might be satisfied with or without the involvement of another person. You might have sexual fantasies, or enjoy sexually explicit content. If you have a low or non-existent libido, then you won't experience sexual urges. Some ace people do have a libido, but what they don't experience is finding other people

sexually attractive. If you experience arousal but don't have any desire to share your sexuality with anyone else, you might be asexual. On the flip side, you might be completely grossed out by any sexual activity, whether it involves you or not (see 'sex repulsion' in our Glossary). Both kinds of asexuals exist, and neither one is 'more' ace than the other.

How do I know if I'm asexual?

If you feel like you're on the ace spectrum, then you probably are! It's completely a matter of self-identification, and if you're questioning it, then that's probably a good hint that you might be ace and/or aro. There is no official check-list for characteristics that will definitively 'prove' you're ace, although there are some common features which might indicate you're on the spectrum. Please bear in mind that these are just how some people experience asexuality, and you might experience none of these things but still be on the spectrum, or you might experience some and not be on the spectrum — it's up to you whether you feel that 'ace' is a term you identify with.

You might be asexual if...

- You've never been interested in another person in a sexual way.
- You've only been sexually attracted to a handful of people in your life.
- You sometimes experience sexual attraction, but it comes in phases, and you go through long periods of time where you experience no sexual attraction at all.
- You've only ever found people sexually attractive after you've gotten to know them really well.
- You've found people attractive, but that's never led to you wanting to have a sexual relationship with them.
- You're not really sure if you've ever experienced sexual attraction.
- You don't fully understand what sexual attraction is, or what it's supposed to feel like.
- You don't really get what the hype with sex is.
- You never really think about other people in a sexual way, and you can't relate when other people say they get crushes — you might think that they're being a bit too dramatic for it to be authentic.
- You've never understood why your friends find certain celebrities or people you know 'hot' or 'sexy'.

- You find sex boring or view it as a chore.
- You've pretended to be interested in sex to fit in, or to please your partner.
- You have no desire to try it, or didn't particularly enjoy it if you did try it.
- You don't mind sex, but you have no real desire for it.
- You've never had a sexual relationship, or you haven't had one in years, and it doesn't bother you at all.
- You never find yourself thinking about sex.
- You think about sex in scientific terms rather than romantic or erotic terms.
- You feel uncomfortable watching sex scenes in movies or reading about them in books, or they just seem forced, awkward, or unnecessary to you.
- Highly-sexualised environments like clubs make you feel out of place.
- You've always assumed that you're straight because it's considered the 'default', but you don't actually find people of a different gender to yours sexually attractive.
- You identify as gay/bi/pan/other, and although you definitely fit that orientation somehow, your attraction isn't sexual in nature, and now you're questioning whether you might be ace.
- The term 'asexuality' is something that clicks with you.

### How do I know if I'm aromantic?

Similarly, there's no single shared experience of aromanticism, and what makes one person aromantic may be completely different to another aro. At its simplest, if you aren't romantically interested in other people, or you have little or no desire to have a romantic relationship, you're probably on the aromantic spectrum. Here are a few things that you might relate to if you're aromantic:

- You've never had any crushes, or only had a few.
- If you've ever dated, maybe you didn't really enjoy it, and there was nothing particularly exciting about it.
- You probably don't spend much time fantasizing about your current or future relationship, or you don't feel like you're 'missing out' on anything by being single.
- Finding a romantic partner feels more like fulfilling an obligation than something you're actually enthusiastic to do.

- Maybe someone's asked you out, but you felt indifferent about it, or even a sense of dread.
- You've felt guilty that you don't 'love' or have strong feelings for your partner.
- Romantic gestures seem more like an unnatural routine you're expected to follow than something guided by intuition.
- You feel freer when you're single.
- You're more excited to make new friends or to meet up with your existing friends than to meet a potential romantic partner.
- You don't want to be alone, but you're fine with being single.
- You're not worried about being single forever.
- Perhaps you don't really get the difference between romantic and friendly feelings, and you don't have much desire to distinguish between them because it's not that important to you.
- You might be completely content with platonic relationships like friendships, and don't hold romance any higher in your mind than friendship.
- Maybe you even think of it as less important, or not important at all.
- You might not really relate to your friends when they talk about their crushes, and don't feel any jealousy when they talk about their relationships.
- You think that the over-the-top things people do for their partners is kind of silly.
- You don't see how finding someone pretty leads to wanting to have a relationship with them.
- You don't feel like you've ever 'fallen in love', and the whole idea seems kind of cheesy and unrealistic to you.
- Perhaps you find romantic plot-twists in books and movies underwhelming, or maybe you enjoy or don't mind them, but don't desire anything similar for yourself.
- You find romance a bit gross.
- The idea of kissing isn't appealing to you at all.
- You don't understand how to flirt, and you're completely oblivious or confused as to when other people are flirting with you, or you have no idea how to respond.
- You avoid going to places where people are likely to flirt with you, such as clubs or bars.

This month, the scouts will be celebrating Imbolc and talking about how we can see the signs of spring even when it's cold and snowy outside. Imbolc translates to “in the belly” and is a time when sheep have their babies and produce milk, giving hope of the spring. It is a time to honor the light of spring and the darkness of winter coming to a close. We begin to plan out the scout gardens and talk about the seeds we planted in the fall waking up beneath the earth. The restorative energy of winter nurtures the seeds and prepares them for the coming season. We ritually clean our scout altar and talk about the need for spring cleaning physically, emotionally and spiritually. Energy is reset and feeling fresh and new so now is the time to let go of anything that is not serving a positive purpose. This history of Imbolc is important to teach the scouts as it goes back thousands of years to ancient Ireland and Scotland. The Goddess Brigid, Celtic Goddess of Fire, is a goddess of fertility, poetry, blacksmithing and the dawn. We celebrate Imbolc with fire to symbolize the spring return. You can give the scouts seed snacks such as muffins or sesame seed bark. We then make Brigid crosses for protection of our houses and the kids take them home. The older scouts make Brigid corn dolls and decorate them with symbols of spring such as seeds, pinecones and leaves. We also honor Cailleach as she is also ruling at this time through the cold and winds, the queen of winter. The story to teach about her is that she would gather wood all day to keep the fire burning so that winter would continue on Imbolc. If the day is sunny, she will emerge and collect her firewood and winter will continue longer, if it is cloudy she will stay in and the fire will burn out bringing a quicker spring. It is very similar to the Groundhog tradition of seeing



its shadow. The children absolutely love these stories and just like our ancestors, it teaches them about the season and they in turn will be able to relate more. Happy Imbolc!

## ARTS & CRAFTS - Herbal Soap

My favorite craft for Imbolc is to make homemade herbal soaps with the kids. The wind is blowing, it's snowing and we are laughing in the kitchen together. Imbolc is a time when the winter is about to transition into springtime and we are getting ready to come out of hibernation. It's also a time of purification and cleansing so soap making is perfect for this holiday. Wash off the negativity and prepare the body for renewal. Be sure to cleanse, charge and consecrate the ingredients before using them and focus on renewal. The soap takes less than an hour to make, a few hours to set up in the molds and up to 3 weeks to fully cure for use.

What you'll need:

- 2 cups packed grated castile soap or any natural cold-pressed vegetable soap
- ½ cup water
- 2 tsp powdered ground sage
- 20 drops lavender essential oil
- Grater
- Measuring cups/spoons
- Large pot with 2 inches of water in it
- Large bowl for mixing that will act as a double boiler with the large pot
- Wooden spoon
- Eye dropper for essential oil
- Molds
- Plastic wrap
- Rubber spatula
- Drying rack
- Dish towels/hot pads
- Large butcher knife
- Rubber stamp to imprint a design on soap if desired



Directions:

1. Grate the soap and place in the bowl. Pour in ½ cup of water.
2. Measure out herbs and oils and set them aside.
3. Place a piece of plastic wrap into each mold so that it lines the mold and has overlap to the edges.
4. Put the bowl on top of the pot with 2 inches of water in it. Place on the stove and heat to high until the water comes to a boil.
5. Reduce heat to a simmer and mix gently to break up the lumps.

6. When all the water and soap are fully mixed together the mixture will look like mashed potatoes with strings. When this occurs, take off the heat and gently mix in sage and oil.
7. Scoop the mixture into the prepared molds and be sure to press with spatula into all of the corners. Bang on counters a few times to remove air bubbles.
8. Let the molds sit for a minimum of 2 hours until it sets. If it is still soft after 5 hours, place it in the freezer for half an hour.
9. Unmold the soap and remove the plastic wrap. If you used a loaf mold, slice into 1 inch thick slices. Put the pieces onto a rack and cover with a towel. The soap will harden in a couple of days, if not you can remelt it and put it back into the molds.
10. Let it cure on the rack in a dry room for 3 weeks. Turn it every day so that it does not warp.
11. Consecrate it with the elements and sit it on your altar during your Imbolc ceremony to soak up the positive energies, then place it on a windowsill to absorb the sun and moon. Just be careful it does not melt! Use the soap to purify your energies and relax yourself after a stressful event.



## *MUSIC - Music of the Spheres and String Theory*


Music of the Spheres or Musica Universalis is an ancient philosophical concept that regards percentage of movement in the celestial bodies as a form of music. This music is not audible but a mathematical concept. The Greek philosopher Pythagoras is credited with the concept, which has arisen from his semi-mystical, semi-mathematical philosophy and its associated system of numerology of Pythagoreanism. During the time of Pythagoras, it was thought the sun, moon and planets were thought to revolve around the Earth in their proper spheres. The spheres were thought to be related by the whole-number ratios of pure musical intervals, creating musical harmony.

It is thought that Pythagoras could hear the 'music of the spheres' enabling him to discover that consonant musical intervals can be expressed in simple ratios of small integers. Tones were correlated with great celestial movements of the day. Pythagoras' concepts were communicated by Plato and others into models about the structure of the universe. Pythagoras told the Egyptian priests that Thoth gave him the ability to hear the music of the spheres. He believed only Egyptians of the right bloodline could access the mysteries.

Pythagoras is credited with having discovered the physical relationship, expressed as ratios, between mass and sound. He was also credited with having developed the monochord which was a stretched gut string on a soundboard with moveable bridges, for testing harmonic properties and their rapport with numerical ratios. The octave ratio of 1:2 means that a mass will produce an octave above the pitch of its full length when it is reduced by one half. For example, the open “A” string of the violin sounds that pitch about vibrations per second. When the string is “stopped” by the violinist’s finger so only half of its original length is vibrating, it sounds an “A” that is an octave higher and vibrates twice as quickly. Simply, to play this musical interval, one part of the string length out of two parts total (1:2) is set to vibration. The ratio for the fifth is 2:3 and that of the fourth is 3:4.

Pythagoras and his followers believed that a universal philosophy could be founded in numbers.

They differentiated three types of music: the music of instruments, the music of the human body and the music of the spheres (Cosmos). Geometric shapes and even orbiting motions could be linked to the philosophy. Arguably Pythagoras could be the first proponent of “string theory” as a tool to understanding the universe and the important tetractys containing the numbers of perfect musical intervals of an octave.



Pythagoras devised a literal “music of the spheres” by using musical intervals to describe

distances between the moon and known. Plato took up the idea of a universal philosophy through numbers and their musical associations and devised a series that he termed the World Soul: 1,2,3,9,8, and 27. By using these as musical ratios (1:2, 2:3, 3:9, etc.), he created a series of musical notes that gave a default mathematical ratio for a half-step. With mathematical derivation, one can arrive at theoretical proportions for non-Pythagorean intervals of seconds, thirds, sixths, and sevenths. These intervals are inherently subjective and context-sensitive.

The notion of the “Music of the Spheres” continues today through studies of cosmic background radiation and “string theory”. Whether that is a theory or not, science has proven that the Cosmos make music but it is at a level that the normal human ear can’t hear, but we can feel it. Our own bodies make music. To understand ourselves and nature we need to become one with music inside of us. Music is like math, its language is universal. In that essence we are universal. Be your music and create your symphony.


## KITCHEN WITCHERY - Soda Bread

Here is an herbal twist on an old recipe. Irish farmers often had no access to ovens or bakeries, soda bread solved this problem as it could be cooked in a cauldron over open hearths. Perfect for Imbolc and the celebration of these hearth fires!

### Ingredients:

- 2 cups flour
- ½ tsp baking soda
- 1 tsp baking powder
- ½ tsp salt
- 2 tbsp finely chopped rosemary, thyme, parsley, basil, sage and tarragon
- 4 oz sharp cheddar cheese
- 1 cup buttermilk
- 1 large egg
- 1 tbsp melted butter
- ¼ cup pine nuts



### Directions:

1. Preheat the oven to 425 degrees fahrenheit.
2. Line a cookie sheet with parchment paper and sprinkle with flour.
3. In a bowl, whisk flour, baking soda, baking powder and salt until combined. Add herbs, cheese and pinenuts. Use your hands to break apart clumps and continue to combine.
4. In a separate bowl, combine buttermilk and egg with a fork. Make a well in flour mixture and add buttermilk mix. Stir until flour is incorporated.
5. Put dough onto a floured work surface and turn several times to coat with flour. Form into a round loaf. Add flour until the dough is no longer sticky.
6. Place dough onto cookie sheet, cut an x into top of the loaf. Tuck the pine nuts into the bread all over the surface and sprinkle with any remaining herbs.
7. Bake for 20 minutes, cover with foil if getting too brown and bake an additional 8 to 10 minutes. Top will be golden brown.
8. Brush the loaf with melted butter and let it cool for 20 minutes. Serve thick slices warm with butter. Enjoy!

## CORRELIAN TEA PARTY - Imbolc Tea



Ah tea! The perfect way to sit and relax after a long day and just inhaling the steam from a special brew is part of the magic. You can even add the mixtures to soy candles to enjoy the scent, the uses of tea are unlimited.

This month's mix is the perfect mix for Imbolc. Earl Grey tea is comforting and warming while dark and quiet. Lavender is good for sleep and dreams which is perfect for this time of hibernation. Rosemary is an herb of remembrance, remembering that spring will return to us again. Milk represents the lactating of the animals of the season. Vanilla, honey and sugar awaken us to the sweet spring that is beginning to bloom.

### Ingredients:

- 1 tbsp loose leaf Earl Grey tea
- 1 tbsp lavender buds
- 1 sprig rosemary
- $\frac{3}{4}$  cup hot water
- $\frac{3}{4}$  cup milk
- $\frac{1}{4}$  tsp vanilla extract
- 1 tsp raw honey
- 1 tbsp brown sugar

### Directions:

1. Combine tea and lavender in a tea infuser.
2. Pour hot water over the infuser and steep for 5 minutes.
3. Boil milk on stove top, stir in vanilla, add sprig of rosemary and press against side of pot to release flavor. Strain.
4. Remove the tea infuser and add sugar and honey into the tea.
5. Pour tea into a mug and top with milk combination. Garnish with lavender and rosemary. Stir and enjoy!



## DEMETER'S FIELDS - Chamomile

Chamomile is a member of the Asteraceae family and has been used for thousands of years. In Egypt it was used as an offering to the gods. It is a masculine plant, ruled by the sun. Its element is water. The two main types of chamomile are *Matricaria recutita* and *Anthemis nobilis* which are used in a variety of ways to support health. Folk names of chamomile are ground apple, heermann chen chameh melon, camomyle, manzanilla, maythen and whig plant.

Chamomile has been shown to ease an upset stomach, heartburn, nausea and vomiting. A mouth rinse will ease mouth sores caused by cancer treatments. Other research has shown that it can help with diarrhea in children, anxiety and insomnia. If used on the skin it can help with skin irritation and wound healing and even be as effective as hydrocortisone cream for eczema. Magically chamomile has the ability to attract money and is used by gamblers in a hand rinse. It is also protective and can be used to combat spells and curses against you. Cosmetically chamomile has also been used as a rinse for accentuating highlights and lightening blonde hair.

Topically, it has an emollient to soften and soothe skin. It has been used in perfumes and even as a flavoring agent in liqueurs such as Benedictine and vermouth. Teas are one of the most common ways chamomile is used.

### Calming Chamomile Latte

- 2 cups waters
- 1 cup unsweetened dairy-free milk (like almond or oat)
- 1 chamomile tea bag or 1 tsp of loose leaf tea
- 5-7 cloves crushed or ½ tbsp of ground cloves
- 5 cardamom pods crushed
- 1 cinnamon stick
- A few sprinkles of cinnamon to top off
- 1-2 tsp of honey to taste

Bring water to boil in a tea kettle. Once boiling, add tea bag (loose tea), cinnamon stick, cardamom pods and cloves. Remove from heat, let steep for 10 mins.

During the last 3-4 mins of steeping, add dairy-free milk to saucepan and simmer over medium heat,

while whisking to get frothy consistency.

Once tea is done steeping. Pour through a mesh strainer and into a mug. Stir in honey and top with warm,

frothy milk and add a few sprinkles of cinnamon.



## CRYSTAL GARDEN - Aura Quartz



The Aura Quartz is full of mesmerizing beauty with a metallic rainbow iridescence that enchants our senses. They are artificially made through alchemy by bonding precious metals onto the surface of a natural clear quartz creating layers of colors and giving the stone an unique energy. It is also soothing during childbirth and the first few years of the baby life as they channel messages from the baby’s angel guides. The ruby and rose aura quartz are ideal for passion, love and self-esteem. They boost romance writers' inspiration as well as those that work with beauty products, hairstyling, modeling and fashion. They find your charisma and beauty and bring it in a way that enhances confidence and self-image.



The aqua aura quartz are focused on the career. It removes restrictions and brings opportunities as it boosts communication. It also aids in travel, development and research careers. The Tanzine aura quartz helps improve intuition. Connecting the wearer with the Akasha and boosts skills of the medium. It supports those working in the psychic fields and protects them as it dissolves negativity. It offers healing for PTSD and other types of victims. The sunshine aura quartz brings out the bright and positive side of life. It is a great stone for those dealing with

## MAGICAL ANIMALS - Opossum

Today I volunteered at the wildlife rehab center again. Some of the animals are overwintering in outdoor enclosures, that mimic as much as possible natural habitats for their species, with hopes they can be released to the wild in the spring. Water and food are refreshed daily, and we make sure they are doing well, bringing any potential ailment to

the attention of our director. Most of the animals stayed in their den boxes while we did our chores. None of them are actually hibernating, but they are in a state of torpor, where their metabolism slows, in an adaptation to the colder temperatures. Only the curious raccoons poked their heads out to see what we were bringing them.

Animals that are younger - late season orphaned babies - or animals that are recovering from physical injuries are housed inside. The morning routine entails cleaning their cages, refreshing water, feeding according to the prescribed diet, and administering any required medications. For some of the animals, cleaning a cage while they are still inside can be a bit of a trick. With some individuals, there is a real bite risk. We work calmly and patiently, and as needed, wear protective gloves.

One of my patients today was an adult opossum, who had been brought to the center with injuries to its front toes. I do not know the cause; fortunately she has been recovering well, but she has no love for any of us. Or at least that's how it seems. Open the cage door to remove dirty blankets and food dishes - SNARL- mouth opened wide, showing an impressive display of teeth. Coming back with a nice soft fleece and fresh food, I am thanked with an even louder snarl, and once again that wide open mouth. I can almost hear her saying: "See these teeth? I mean business!!! You come near me, and you will get it!!"

Was I intimidated? Well, yes, even though I know in my head her behavior was an adaptive, protective mechanism. I covered my gloved hands with a fleece, gently pushed her to one side of the cage so I could proceed with my work, then repeated the process on the other side. A bit later I came back to witness her avidly eating her breakfast. Made me feel good.

Possoms are very unique animals. They are the only marsupial found in North America; once considered a southern mammal, they have gradually expanded their range northward. They are nomadic and solitary, and despite their nasty snarl when threatened, they are usually nonaggressive. "Playing possum" is another behavior exhibited when danger is present - one I have witnessed firsthand. The opossum truly looks dead, but in a short period, after the immediate threat dissipates, they can make a fast exit. This is thought to be an involuntary, physiological response, rather than a conscious act.



What can the opossum teach us? Possoms are very resilient animals, capable of adapting to many different environments. They are survivors, using their capabilities in response to the circumstance at hand. Because they are known for "playing dead", possums sometimes are known as tricksters, symbolizing deception, illusions, protective measures and problem solving.

If you encounter an opossum, what can this mean? Are you in a difficult situation? Perhaps it's best to be still, and wait for the danger or current situation to pass. Possums usually look for the path of least resistance. Consider, what is worth fighting for, or is it time to walk away from a situation to keep yourself physically, mentally, spiritually whole? Look at the obstacles ahead of you; sometimes the best path forward is the one that navigates around boulders.

Although possums are creatures of the night, they can also represent light and hope. In some cultures, possums are symbols of good luck, fertility, and abundance. Like the possum, be confident that you have what it takes to survive, and that you can work beyond difficult circumstances to eventual success.

Imbolc is the awakening of nature but it is also a time of sleep as winter is still upon us. As witches we are in tune with the earth's cycles and tend to sleep more during the winter/hibernation months. 



## CALENDAR - February

All times are Eastern Standard Time



February is named after Februs, the Roman God of Purification. He is a god of the underworld to the Sabine people of the Apennines. The Etruscans also worshiped him and was adopted by the Romans as a God of spring cleaning. This led to the annual festival of Februalia, the spring festival of washing and purification. The land was typically prepared during this time for the planting of seeds and cleansing rituals were encouraged. Eventually Februs' name was changed to Pluto but the name of the month continued to remain February.







### *RITUAL OF THE MONTH - Rainbow Chakra Blessing*



Correllian Wicca: Ritual in Theory and Practice. Available for PRE-ORDER. Hardcover and Paperback available. Written by Rev. Don Lewis, edited by Rev. Ser Eboni Nash.

The Maiden Goddess is associated with self-expression, creativity, and color. She is the Goddess of the many-colored dawn, of the variegated flowers that come with spring, and of the rainbow. In this act of power we will make use of the symbolism of the rainbow and its connection to the seven chakras and the seven planes.

For this act of power you will need seven candles, in seven colors associated with the seven major chakras: red, orange, yellow, green, light blue, dark blue, and purple. Arrange them in a row or in a circle on an altar at the center of the ritual space. Or if you are so motivated, you might obtain one of the seven-color candelabras that are available in some metaphysical shops, which arch like the rainbow and hold votive candles.

As each candle is lit during the ceremony, a blessing will be given. It is nice if each of the seven blessings can be given by a different person, but this is by no means necessary. In fact, they

can all be done by one person if need be, but it is best to share them so that more people take an active role. The more people who take an active role in ritual, the more emotionally successful the ritual is apt to be.

You will want to begin by discussing the concepts involved. You might say something like: "Candlemas is the feast of light. Now light is returning to the world. The Maiden Goddess is the Goddess of light - the light of the waxing moon, the light of the dawn. The light of the rainbow. The rainbow reveals the spectrum of light, its parts and qualities. As the rainbow symbolically corresponds to the divine archetypes, revealing the parts and qualities of Deity,



so too the rainbow corresponds to the seven planes, revealing the parts and qualities of existence. So too the rainbow corresponds to the seven chakras, revealing the parts and qualities of the body's major energy centers. Through the rainbow a range of blessings are given. Tonight we honor the Maiden and her rainbow also."

You will also want to explain the mechanics. You might put it this way: "During this rite we will invoke the powers of the rainbow and its correspondences, attuning to them and receiving their blessings. This ritual calls for a chant, in which all will join after each blessing. The words are simple: 'Blessed be the Holy Ones! Seven powers born in light. Blessed is as blessed does. Blessed be this holy night!' Now let us begin."

Now let the red candle be lit and a blessing said. After the blessing all will join in a chant. As the candle is lit, the person lighting it should envision it surrounded by a ball of clear white light and focus on this as they give the blessing. The blessing might be along these lines: Red: "Mine is the red flame of Saturn, the Crone. I bless this assemblage with vitality and practicality. May you always have the resources and support you need in life. May you learn your lessons and teach in your turn." All: "Blessed be the Holy Ones! Seven powers are born in light. Blessed is as blessed does. Blessed be this holy night!"

Now let the orange candle be lit and a blessing said. As the candle is lit, the person lighting it should envision it surrounded by a ball of clear white light and focus on this as they give the blessing. The blessing could go something like this: Orange: "Mine is the orange flame of Mars, the Hero. I bless this assemblage with creativity and passion. May you always have joy and

excitement in life. May you receive pleasure and give pleasure in your turn.” All: “Blessed be the Holy Ones! Seven powers born in light. Blessed is as blessed does. Blessed be this holy night!”



Now let the yellow candle be lit and a blessing said. As the candle is lit, the person lighting it should envision it surrounded by a ball of clear white light and focus on this as they give the blessing. The blessing would be to this effect: Yellow: “Mine is the yellow flame of Sun, the Lover. I bless this assemblage with courage and self-assurance. May you always have confidence and integrity in life. May you be encouraged and encourage others in your turn.” All:

“Blessed be the Holy Ones! Seven powers born in light. Blessed is as blessed does. Blessed be this holy night!”

Now let the green candle be lit and a blessing said. As the candle is lit, the person lighting it should envision it surrounded by a ball of clear white light and focus on this as they give the blessing. The blessing might be in terms like these: Green: “Mine is the green flame of Venus, the Maiden. I bless this assemblage with love and healing. May you always have balance and harmony in life. May you be loved and love in your turn.” All: “Blessed be the Holy Ones! Seven powers born in light. Blessed is as blessed does. Blessed be this holy night!”

Now let the light blue candle be lit and a blessing said. As the candle is lit, the person lighting it should envision it surrounded by a ball of clear white light and focus on this as they give the blessing. The blessing should be along these lines: Light Blue: “Mine is the light blue flame of Mercury, the Sorcerer. I bless this assemblage with intelligence and willpower. May you always have clarity and focus in life. May you gain knowledge and share it in your turn.” All: “Blessed be the Holy Ones! Seven powers born in light. Blessed is as blessed does. Blessed be this holy night!”

Now let the dark blue candle be lit and a blessing said. As the candle is lit, the person lighting it should envision it surrounded by a ball of clear white light and focus on this as they give the blessing. The blessing might be to this effect: Dark Blue: “Mine is the dark blue flame of Moon, the Mother. I bless this assemblage with psychic perception and magical ability. May you always be guided by and connected to your Higher Self in life. May you receive many blessings

and give blessings in your turn.” All: “Blessed be the Holy Ones! Seven powers born in light. Blessed is as blessed does. Blessed be this holy night!”

Now let the purple candle be lit and a blessing said. As the candle is lit, the person lighting it should envision it surrounded by a ball of clear white light and focus on this as they give the blessing. The blessing would go something like this: Purple: “Mine is the purple flame of Jupiter, the King. I bless this assemblage with spiritual understanding and wisdom. May you always know Goddess and see her hand in your life. May you have enlightenment and guide others in your turn.” All: “Blessed be the Holy Ones! Seven powers born in light. Blessed is as blessed does. Blessed be this holy night!”



Now join hands around the candles on their altar. You might say something like this: “Behold the rainbow - the seven colors of creation. Remember their blessings and consider how these might affect you in your life. Imagine the energy of these blessings as a ball of clear, white light surrounding the candles. See that light grow brighter and stronger. As we chant, focus energy into that light, that these blessings may be amplified and multiplied.”

Continue the chant; if space and inclination allow, you may wish to dance as well. Imagine the energy growing as you do so. “Blessed be the Holy Ones! Seven powers born in light! Blessed is as blessed does. Blessed be this holy night! Blessed be the Holy Ones! Seven powers born in light! Blessed is as blessed does. Blessed be this holy night! Blessed be the Holy Ones! Seven powers born in light! Blessed is as blessed does. Blessed be this holy night! Blessed be! Blessed be!”


Now focus and release the energy. You might do it like this: “Imagine that ball of energy growing brighter and brighter, stronger and stronger, shining out in all directions like a sun in the center of our circle - and let us see that ball of light rise up, up, up - higher and higher, see the energy rise up and prepare to release it...now! And see the energy going out into manifestation in a flash of brilliant light!” Now continue with your ritual.

## ANCESTOR OF THE MONTH - Blv. Frank High Correll

### BIOGRAPHY:

Beloved Frank High Correll was the firstborn son of Caroline High Correll, founder of the Correllian Tradition. Blv. Frank was a writer, poet, and historian. Blv. Frank married once and had two children. Blv. Frank became First Elder in 1928 and retained the office until 1931 when he succeeded his uncle William I High as First Priest.

Blv. Frank remained First Priest until his death in 1944, being succeeded by his younger brother William II High Correll. Blv. Frank's primary influence on the Tradition was placing an emphasis on record keeping and preserving the past, although later generations might wish he had preserved more. Because of Blv. Frank, maintaining the history of the Tradition became an aspect of the office of First Priest.

As an Ancestor Blv. Frank is the Patron Ancestor of writers and publishers.

Blv. Frank's card means that you need to pay attention to details. Make sure that you are dotting your "I's" and crossing your "T's". The 'big picture' may look rosy but not paying attention to the little things can trip you up, so make sure that you are on solid ground with these. It is said that you cannot build a house without first building the foundation and this card suggests that your foundation may need attention in order to have a good outcome to the situation in question.

One may ask who's the Wandering Witch and I suggest you visit Lady Laurie Denman's page with her Adventures as she is the Wandering Witch. Then why am I the one writing about a week from her Adventures? I had the pleasure of meeting our Lady in Greece for the first time and I want to share the experience.

I think that most of us, Correllians, when we get a message from an Elder or an ArchPriest or from the First Priesthood, we start to sweat, wondering "what's going on", "have I done something wrong?". Well, that's what happened to me when Lady Laurie asked me whether she could visit Serpent of Hermes Temple as she was planning a trip to Athens, Greece. I'll be very honest, I was excited and panicked. It was the first time since I joined the CNT back in 6 Aq that a member of the Council of Elders and the Master of Records to boot would visit Greece... and then she came, and we loved every minute of it!

She was flying Monday 26<sup>th</sup> of December and she would miss her Temple's Yule, we were supposed to have our ritual on 23<sup>rd</sup>. Guess what? We changed it and invited her to celebrate with us and our first memories started to take form. A Yule ritual combined with a New Moon Handfasting for two couples, both renewing their vows and strengthening their bonds.

Day 2: After we let her rest for a few hours, we decided to test her limits! Yes, she can handle a lot of walking and she has so much energy! Our first visit was to Acropolis, the most popular and special place one will ever see in Athens. The special part wasn't the climbing of so many stairs or the waiting or even going rounds on the site itself but the fact that she managed to charge and plant a crystal for the Crystal Web and she did it so naturally, no one noticed.

One (or more) meditation under the shadow of the Parthenon and a visit at Erechtheion after, we descended and headed for our meal for the day and she surprised us again because she did know many traditional dishes! Day 4 and when plans are made to change! Since we started planning the trip once we had the dates, Lady Laurie suggested that Thalia (the Joint Head) and I wanted to re-do the Third Degree initiation due to many (mostly personal reasons). We said "yay" and so Thursday was the day in the calendar. The twist you may ask. Change of venue for the 3<sup>rd</sup> time. We were supposed to combine it with a trip outside Athens, to a special place where a fireplace would warm us and the seaside would paint the background but due to my work obligations, we had to change. Then, we as a Temple, have a place we rent for the rituals but it became unavailable, so we ended up doing it at our Temple's base (or living room of my place) and it was very cozy, very powerful and a reminder of all we work for all these many years. 
