

## **Chosen Path Church Membership Code of Conduct**

- ❖ All members are expected to recognize the Divine in themselves and fellow Members, regardless of the path followed by fellow Members.
- ❖ All members shall conduct themselves in a manner that is a positive reflection of the Church's Code of Conduct and Guiding Principles, as published on the Church's website.
- ❖ All members shall respect fellow members' chosen spiritual path even though it may not be their own.
- ❖ All members shall respect Clergy as those who have devoted their lives in service of the Divine.
- ❖ All members shall not reveal fellow members' membership in the Church outside of the Church membership as not all members have been public about their spiritual path.
- ❖ Members must keep their Church Roster personal information current at all times, updating when necessary, the following: Legal name, Date of Birth, physical home address, phone number, and active email address. Updates can be sent to ChosenPathChurch@gmail.com.
- ❖ All members will be asked to reaffirm their membership and update personal information on an annual basis. This will be completed prior to the Annual Corporate Meeting. Members who fail to reaffirm by the stated deadline will be removed from membership.
- ❖ Immediate family household members are welcome to accompany Members to Church related activities.
- ❖ Any non-household immediate family members or friends of Members are required to attend a publicly held Meet and Greet with the High Priesthood before being invited to the Church grounds or having that location of the Church revealed to them.
- ❖ Parents, Grandparents, or Guardians are responsible for the behavior of their minor household members and any damage the minor does to the Church's physical properties or the resident High Priesthood's personal property.
- ❖ The High Priesthood reserves the right to communicate when a minor child is being disruptive and should be taken home. The Member must comply with this decision immediately in an undistruptive manner.
- ❖ The High Priesthood reserves the right to communicate that the minor child cannot attend future Church activities until they gain the necessary maturity to function at Church activities without being disruptive.
- ❖ Members, immediate family household members, and guests are responsible for damage they cause to the Church's physical properties or the resident High Priesthood's personal properties and must make appropriate compensation.
- ❖ No member shall disclose the physical location of the Church to any non-Members to minimize the personal risk to the resident High Priesthood. A generalization of the area of town is acceptable.
  - Members who disclose the physical location of the Temple without express permission of the resident High Priesthood will be subject to immediate

- removal as voted on by a simple majority of the Board of Directors. No warning process is required before this vote.
- The resident High Priesthood reserves the right to demand any Member, or their immediate family household member or guest, remove themselves from the Church grounds at any time.
  - Former Members who have had their Church membership revoked by the Board of Directors that enter the Church grounds uninvited by the resident High Priesthood will be considered trespassers and appropriate legal action will be taken.
- ❖ Members shall not disclose any confidential information to outside parties without the fellow member's express written permission, authorized by a properly executed court subpoena, or as required for government filings by the Church. Outside parties are defined as persons other than the Church's High Priesthood and Board of Directors.
